Keynote Speech


“Swimming Jewels”: The birth history of Nishikigoi and their charms.

We can trace the origins of Nishikigoi, sometimes called “living jewels” or “swimming artworks,” to the edible carp bred in the mountainous area of Nijumurago, located between Nagaoka City and Ojiya City, Niigata Prefecture.

Since then, a repeated selective breeding process over a long period of time led to its current appearance. In addition, it has been developed worldwide as a global ornamental fish culture.

Today, I would like to introduce the history of the birth of Nishikigoi, its charm as a symbol of Japanese aesthetics, and how it has become a “global ornamental fish” currently cherished by Japanese people and many people outside Japan as well.


Mr. SUGA Yutaka

His research focuses on folklore in Japan and China.
In his pursuit of fields and actual sites for his research, he has conducted long-term research on the cultural history of the ornamental fish Nishikigoi, which originated in Niigata Prefecture.
In 2017, he cooperated in the application for the first Japanese Nationally Important Agricultural Heritage Systems with the Nagaoka-Ojiya “Birthplace of Nishikigoi” Revitalization Promotion Council (Secretariat: Nagaoka City and Ojiya City) for “Rice and carp cultivation that takes advantage of the blessing of snow.” (Recognized on March 14, 2017)
In the same year, he assumed the position of chairman of the “Nishikigoi Reviewing Committee,” when Nishikigoi was designated as the “Ornamental Fish in Niigata Prefecture,” on May 5, 2017.
He is also active as a “seko” (one of several “matadors” who face the bulls) in Ojiya Bull-Sumo, and in 2022, assumed the position of president of Ojiya Bull-Sumo Promotion Council.
He is the author of many books.

Mr. TAIRA Masaaki

Born in Tokyo in 1967.
Graduated from Waseda University School of Law; former President of Yamakuni, a wholesaler trading in the Ota Vegetable and Fruit Market, as the third generation to inherit the business; former Chief Director, Tokyo Junior Chamber Inc.
In 2005, he became an official candidate for the Liberal Democratic Party (hereinafter, “LDP”) as the result of an open competition in which the success ratio was 1 in 43, and first ran in the Lower House General Election, winning a seat.
In 2012, he assumed the office of Parliamentary Vice-Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry, and promoted reforms from the perspective of users, such as the establishment of mirasapo (www.mirasapo.jp).
In 2014, he became State Minister of Cabinet Office, working on key policies such as “regional revitalization”, “National Strategic Special Zones”, and “Cool Japan”.
In 2019, he was appointed to the post of State Minister of the Cabinet Office a second time, setting out strategic innovations such as “Disaster Management & Technology (IT)”.
As of November 2022, he is Director, Special Committee on Promotion of Science and Technology, and Innovation; Director-General, Information Research Bureau, LDP; Director, Internet Media Division, LDP; Head, Project Team on web3, LDP; and Chairperson, Policy Research Council, Federation of Tokyo Prefecture LDP Party Branches, among other posts.

Born in Niigata Prefecture in 1988. Chair of the Cool Japan EXPO in NIIGATA Executive Committee.
After graduating from the National Institute of Technology, Nagaoka College, he transferred onto a course in the College of Policy and Planning Sciences, University of Tsukuba.
After working for GREE, Inc., he founded Fuller, Inc. in November 2011, and assumed the post of Representative Director.
In 2016, he was selected for inclusion in the “30 under 30”, a list of the most important people under 30 years old issued by Forbes, one of the world’s leading business magazines.
In June 2020, he moved back to his hometown, Niigata. He was selected to be Representative Director of the Niigata Venture Association in September of the same year.
In October 2020, he was appointed as a Visiting Professor at the National Institute of Technology, Nagaoka College.
In December 2021, he was awarded the EY Entrepreneur of the Year 2021 Japan Prize.
His dream is to create the most attractive company in the world.
He is the author of “Entrepreneurial Friendship”.

In 2012, he took up the position of Vice Chair of the Board of the national association, and in 2018, he became the national Chair of the Board.
In May 2022, All Japan Nishikigoi Promotion Association was incorporated, and he remains its present Chair of the Board.
He has been invited to give lectures to groups of nishikigoi enthusiasts within Japan and abroad, and has contributed to the diffusion of judging techniques at exhibitions.
He also participates in many exhibitions around the world as a judge.
Through these exhibitions and other opportunities, he is active in disseminating information on nishikigoi, which exploit Japan’s strengths to the full, to foreign countries as an element of Cool Japan.
